# Fulbright IEA

- **(New) France and Senegal (HBCU IEA Program)** –Deadline: September 16, 2024
  - Senior-level administrators (deans, directors, vice presidents, provosts, and presidents) OR International education administrators (foreign student advisors, study abroad advisors, and foreign student admissions staff)
- **India** – Deadline: September 16, 2024
  - Senior- level administrators OR international education administrators
- **Taiwan** – Deadline: September 16, 2024
  - Senior-level administrators with substantial international dimension OR study abroad advisor
- **Japan** – Deadline: November 1, 2024
  - International education administrators OR senior-level administrators
- **Korea** – Deadline: November 1, 2024
  - International education administrator
- **France** – Deadline: February 3, 2025
  - Senior-level administrator
- **Germany** – Deadline: February 3, 2025
  - Administrator who enhances international dimension (foreign student admissions and advising, study abroad programs, and international exchanges) OR career services OR alumni affairs OR development and fundraising

- Accommodations, health insurance coverage, and most meals, \$1,400 stipend for airfare
- Lectures, workshops, campus visits, and cultural visits

# Types of Fulbright Programs

- **Open Study/Research Programs**
  - Traditional award opportunity where a candidate designs a proposal for a specific country
  - Design a proposal for a specific country
- **English Teaching Assistant Programs**
  - Place grantees in schools overseas to supplement local English language instruction and to provide a native speaker presence in the classrooms
- **Fulbright-Fogarty Fellowships in Public Health**
  - For students enrolled in graduate or medical school (not doctorate); will provide support to the research training site and may provide orientation for the fellows at the NIH
- **Fulbright-National Geographic Award**
  - Undertake an in-depth examination of globally relevant issues as an add-on to the Fulbright Open Study/Research project.

# Gilman Scholarship Program

- March 7, 2024 deadline approaching
- Nearly 3,000 scholarships of up to \$5,000 to cover costs including program tuition, room and board, books, local transportation, insurance, international airfare, passport and visa fees.
- Must be Pell-eligible at time of application
- Study and internship abroad

- Immersive summer opportunity for American college and university students to learn languages essential to America's engagement with the world.
- Enrolled undergraduate or graduate student; 8-10 weeks in the summer
- Languages offered:
  - Arabic
  - Azerbaijani
  - Chinese
  - Hindi
  - Indonesian
  - Japanese
  - Korean
  - Persian
  - Portuguese
  - Russian
  - Swahili
  - Turkish
